Flexible Study Options

Students can study towards the BTh on campus in Henderson and Christchurch or by Distance Learning. This programme also allows for a range of flexible learning options, including a combination of on campus and Distance Learning courses, as well as part-time study.

2025 Fees

Domestic: \$891 per 15-credit course. \$7,128 for one year (8 courses, 120 credits).

International: \$3,015 per 15-credit course. \$24,120 for one year (8 courses, 120 credits).

NOTE: programme is three years and annual fee may vary. A Student Services fee of \$4.20 per credit is charged for on-campus courses or \$63 per semester for distance learning. Please refer to Fee Schedule for more details (www.laidlaw.ac.nz/fees)

Courses

The Bachelor of Theology is a three year full-time (or part-time equivalent) programme. The usual programme structure is 24 courses at 15 credits each at levels 5,6 and 7; however, there are also two 30-credit internship courses on offer in the programme.
